CONGRATULATIONS AMBERLEY

Amberley, Class 9 entered a photo for the Youth Law Photo Competition advertised in the Friday Flyer a few weeks ago. The topic was "what inspires awe". She was awarded 4th place and a \$50 prize. Here's Amberley's submission:

"Every year in spring, cherry

blossoms are in full bloom for less than a month. During this short period, they showcase their beauty to us, a reminder that we should give every opportunity big or small our absolute best. This is why cherry blossoms, and this photo brings me awe".

One of those emails I sent out was to the NZ Sailing Trust to see if I could come sail as crew on their amazing yachts, Lion NZ and Steinlager 2. To my surprise, not only did they reply but they generously gave me a job on the spot. After some official documents to fill in, I was officially a crew volunteer to help sail the boat with other young people from schools for corporate charters as team building experiences.

My latest trip was to the Bay of Islands to assist with the delivery of Lion NZ which is essentially a racing superyacht, 80ft in length and sailed by Sir Peter Blake to come 2nd in the Whitbread Round the World Race. His last Whitbread boat, Steinlager 2 is 84ft and won all of the 6 legs in the Round the World Race.

Lion NZ was brought up on the 26th April 2022 to give northern schools the opportunity to experience a fine piece of history, and I was invited to sail the boat back down to Auckland. I embarked on a two day voyage, sailing past the amazing Hole in the Rock with massive 2 metre swells against us. Unfortunately the wind was not in our favour and we had to sail upwind all through the night, and I got slightly seasick due to the awkward motion of the boat (this boat wasn't designed to sail upwind for the most part, although they will do that quite happily in flatter water). We did this trip in two parts - Opua to Whangarei and then back down to Auckland.

What I learnt the most from this profound experience is that if you have something that you would like to do in life, just go out there and do it. It does not matter if you have no experience in that field. In my experience, to score a great job you need to be motivated, turn up, be willing to learn, and have a good sense of humour. Fortune favours the brave and sometimes all you have to do is ask.






My journey all started in lockdown when I was bored, and I decided to reach out to various organisations for fun - a test to determine what opportunities existed out there in the world.


