# Whiria te tangata - weave the people together.

Within Steiner education, language learning has been described as an opportunity "to develop an ever-widening palette of inner colours".<sup>1</sup>

This year at Waiatarua we are happy to announce a new initiative to grow te reo me ōna tikanga Māori within our school. A group of kaiako have been working together to develop a curriculum support programme for teaching staff that helps

uphold the amazing mahi that has been carried out by others here in the past. Our work is informed by both the te reo course some of our staff are attending, and He Reo Puāwai, our national te reo curriculum guidelines for Steiner Schools in Aotearoa.

#### Our focus across the kura this year will be

*whakawhanaungatanga* – the act of getting to know each other and building relationships.

Growing connections and working collectively is at the core of all things Māori and so it is fitting that relationship and identity building is where we pick up this mahi together. Our primary focus will be on learning our mihimihi (learning how to introduce ourselves in te reo Māori) and developing our ability to greet each other and ask how we are doing in te reo. Alongside this will be a collection of phrases that we will use in classrooms and all around the school, in the hope that these terms become part of our everyday. The resources will be shared across the whole school and kindergarten, and we also hope to bring you along on the journey by sharing our new phrases and mahi with you here.

Through taking up this work in growing our capacity with language, we will not only be growing our ability to see the world through another's eyes, but also strengthening our own place in



I read a beautiful quote that said a language teacher in a Waldorf school has a special role in helping enrich the environment so a "true sense of [connection] may arise among human beings." Or as Efeso Collins said in Samoan in his maiden speech at parliament so soon before he sadly passed away this week, "E le tu fa'amaugaa se tagata"— "no one stands alone".

Whiria te tangata – weave the people together – our hope is that this project is another strand in our continued endeavour to work together and support each other as a school community.




