STUDENT ID PHOTOS CLASSES 7-12

Classes 7 to 12 will have their **ID photos** taken on **Wednesday 26th February** in the morning. Please ensure that students arrive to school on time, wearing the correct dress code, as photography will start first thing in the morning.





