# Class 10 Surveying Camp

As part of our Surveying main lesson, we went on a camp for 2 nights to Whatipu which is about 45km out on the west coast of Auckland.

The practical component of Surveying was carried out on this camp. Students worked collaboratively in groups, utilizing their knowledge of Linear and Radial Surveying techniques. They measured distances between posts using measuring tapes and bearings using a compass. They produced a scaled map of the surveyed area (Whatipu Campsite) using the data collected and presented it in the form of a poster.

We stayed at the Whatipu lodge in one of the oldest building in New Zealand that is still liveable. During our downtime we visited the Whatipu beach and explored the Whatipu caves.

Overall, this camp provided students an opportunity for experiential learning and challenged their practical and mental capacities.




