### STRIKE ACTION - THURSDAY 23 OCTOBER

We received notification this morning from the National Executive of PPTA Te Wehengarua and NZEI Te Riu Roa regarding the scheduled strike action taking place on Thursday, 23 October.

As a result, there will be **no kindergarten or school** operating on that day. The majority of our administration, kindergarten, lower school, and high school teachers are members of these unions and will be participating in the strike.

**Exception:** The **Class 9 camp** will continue as planned next week. PPTA staff attending the camp are exempt from participating in the strike.

We would like to thank all our staff, students, and whānau for the positivity and support you bring to our community. Working together to ensure that every student can achieve their best remains at the heart of what we do. Your understanding and ongoing support are sincerely appreciated.


Bring gloves and any hand gardening tools that might be useful. Families from all other classes are also very welcome.

- Make your cakes look pretty! If you are looking for inspiration, there are many wonderful sites on the internet.



### **Food for Thought from the RSST**

The International Campus Waldorf lecture series for this year is well underway with the aim

"...to take a closer look at Waldorf education in its pedagogical, social and cultural context. The aim is not only to give a basic introduction or mainly describe the ideal of Waldorf education (although that is also the point), but to take a more detailed look at how it really is in various aspects. The real existing Waldorf education will be questioned on the basis of existing research and many years of experience: What does Waldorf really achieve? Where and how should and must Waldorf continue to develop? What are the current challenges facing Waldorf education?"

The lectures so far have been really interesting and enjoyable. The format is in Zoom with one hour from an expert speaker, followed by 30 minutes of audience questions and discussion. You are equally able to just sit and absorb the content, or to engage and ask questions and make comments.
